LARA-ENRIQUEZ: Susan, you can go ahead 8 9 and unmute yourself. 10 PUBLIC SPEAKER: Okay. Thank you for holding 11 this hearing. I'm looking at the document called Plan Bay 12 Area Strategy for a Sustainable Region which was 13 published or adopted July 18, 2013. 14 So one of the things that always stood out to 15 me about that is that in the target for equitable access, 16 target 7, it concluded that the plan in 2013 moves in the 17 18 wrong direction. The share of household income needed to cover 19 20 transportation and housing costs is projected to rise by three percentage points to 69 percent for low income and 21 22 lower middle income residents during the Plan Bay Area 23 period. 24 So how is this -- is -- is -- are you finding by the fact that I think you reported earlier that this 25
