GreenTRIP ADDRESSES...

DEMAND FOR WALKABLE NEIGHBORHOODS NEAR TRANSIT

• Families recognize that being closer to work, groceries, entertainment and parks saves them time and money.

HOUSEHOLD SAVINGS

• By living in walkable communities where driving is not required, households save significantly on costs of transportation and owning multiple cars.

INCREASING TRAFFIC + GREENHOUSE GASES

Transportation causes 50% of our greenhouse gases (GHGs). GreenTRIP
certified projects reduce transportation-caused GHGs by locating in
walkable neighborhoods near transit and by implementing the most
effective traffic reduction strategies.

STATE CLIMATE CHANGE LAWS

 California's climate change laws require reductions in GHGs through coordination of housing and transportation planning. Infill, transit-oriented development can reduce growth in driving and contribute to long-term GHG reductions.



Fully Certified Projects



The Crossings in San Leandro, a mixedused, transit-oriented development next to the downtown San Leandro BART Station, includes:

- The Alameda, with 100 affordable homes, and
- Cornerstone, a 200-unit mixed-use residential project. All parking spaces at Cornerstone will be unbundled and leased separately from the cost of housing.



South Hayward BART Affordable Family and Senior Housing Project,

a proposed 206-unit, 3- to 5-story mixed-use apartment complex next to the South Hayward BART Station. Eden Housing, the developer, will offer two AC Transit passes at a deep discount to each household for the life of the project.

Conditionally Certified Projects

Station Park Green, a 12-acre transit-oriented mixed-use development in San Mateo:

- Includes 599 residential units, office facilities, retail establishments and restaurants.
- EBL&S, the developer, is committed to providing a car-share pod on-site with free membership to all eligible residents for the life of the project.

Parker Place, a 155-unit mixed-used project in downtown Berkeley. City Centric, the developer, has committed to both unbundling parking from housing and offering two AC Transit Easy Passes at a deep discount to each household for the life of the project.

The Ohlone, a proposed 800-unit, 16-story, mixed-use apartment complex ½-mile from the VTA's San Jose Diridon Station. Green Republic, the developer, will offer two VTA transit passes at a deep discount to each household for the life of the project.
